	The word הָיָה means "to exist" or "to be" or "to become" or "to come into being" and occurs 3561 times in the Old Testament.
	This is the foundational verb of existence, identity, becoming and occurrence.
	* It is used in the creation narrative of Genesis 1, represented by the English words Genesis 1:3Exodus 3:12Ruth 1:1Isaiah 2:2 הָאוֹפֵן
ESV	And as for their appearance, the four had the same likeness, as if a wheel were within a wheel.
NIV	As for their appearance, the four of them looked alike; each was like a wheel intersecting a wheel.
NLT	All four wheels looked alike and were made the same; each wheel had a second wheel turning crosswise within it.

The definite article τέσσαρσιν ὃν τρόπον ὅταν ἦplugin-autotooltip\_default plugin-autotooltip bigεἰμί

εἰμί is the first person singular verb for "to be" (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = "to be").

It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. τροχὸς ἐνρlugin-autotooltip bigἐν

Preposition meaning "in". μέσω τροχοῦ
