ESV	Is wood taken from it to make anything? Do people take a peg from it to hang any vessel on it?
NIV	Is wood ever taken from it to make anything useful? Do they make pegs from it to hang things on?
NLT	Can its wood be used for making things, like pegs to hang up pots and pans?

Usage in the New Testament The sense of πᾶς depends on whether it modifies a singular or plural noun, and whether that noun is countable or uncountable.
