The Hebrew אַת word does not have a corresponding word in English. In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence. It only ever occurs in conjunction with nouns associated with the definite article הַ Genesis 1:1. בְּרִיתְּוֹ לְעָמְדֶהַ

ESV that the kingdom might be humble and not lift itself up, and keep his covenant that it might stand.
