	hebrew The Hebrew את word does not have a corresponding word in English. In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence. 	hebrew Meaning: * Wind * Breath * Spirit Noun. Occurs about 380 times in the Old Testament.
