Hebrew	The word וְהָיָה means “to exist” or “to be” or “to become” or “to come into being” and occurs 3561 times in the Old Testament. This is the foundational verb of existence, identity, becoming and occurrence. * It is used in the creation narrative of Genesis 1, represented by the English words Genesis 1:3Exodus 3:12Ruth 1:1Isaiah 2:2 לֹא מִטּוֹת עֵץ אֶל שִׁבְטֵי מַשְׁלִים וְתַגְבָּה קוֹמְתוֹ עַל בֵּין עֲבֹתִים וַיֵּרָא בְּגִבּוֹלוֹ בָּרֶב דְּלִיתֵי
ESV	Its strong stems became rulers' scepters; it towered aloft among the thick boughs; it was seen in its height with the mass of its branches.
NIV	Its branches were strong, fit for a ruler's scepter. It towered high above the thick foliage, conspicuous for its height and for its many branches.
NLT	Its branches became strong— strong enough to be a ruler's scepter. It grew very tall, towering above all others. It stood out because of its height and its many lush branches.
