Hebrew	* Yahweh - God's personal name It is not a generic term for "god", but rather the word יְהוָה (YHWH) is the name by which God uniquely identifies himself in the Old Testament. In Greek philosophy, λόγος was the rational principle that ordered the universe, the divine reason that structured all things.
