| NIV    | Return the sword to its scabbard. In the place where you were created, in the land of your ancestry, I will judge you. |
| NLT    | “Now return the sword to its sheath, for in your own country, the land of your birth, I will pass judgment upon you.   |

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|  | <div>ἀπόστρεφε μὴ καταλύσης ἐν</div> <div>greek</div> <div>Preposition meaning “in”. τῷ</div> <div>greek</div> <div>Meaning:</div> <div>* The</div> <div>The definite article.</div> <div>Forms</div> <div>Singular Case Masculine Feminine Neuter Nominative ὁ ἡ τό Genitive τοῦ τῆς τοῦ Dative τῷ τῇ τόπῳ τούτῳ</div> <div>greek</div> <div>Meaning:</div> <div>* These or this * This one, this person, this thing * They or he or she or it</div> <div>Demonstrative pronoun.</div> <div>οὗτος usually refers to something close to the speaker — “this” as opposed to ἐκεῖνος (John 9:161 John 5:111 Corinthians 15:501 John 4:9John 5:1Matthew 3:17John 7:26Luke 22:19 οὗτος / αὕτη / τοῦτο</div> <div>greek</div> <div>Meaning:</div> <div>* Who * Which * What</div> <div>The relative pronoun that connects a relative clause to a main clause, referring back to a noun or pronoun (called the antecedent).</div> <div>LXX</div> <div>It is distinct from ὅτι (“that,” introducing indirect speech) and from ὅς as an interrogative in older Greek (meaning γενένησαι</div> <div>greek</div> <div>Preposition meaning “in”. τῇ</div> <div>greek</div> <div>Meaning:</div> <div>* The</div> <div>The definite article.</div> <div>Forms</div> <div>Singular Case Masculine Feminine Neuter Nominative ὁ ἡ τό Genitive τοῦ τῆς τοῦ Dative τῷ τῇ γῇ</div> <div>Meaning:</div> <div>* Soil or ground (e.g. Matthew 13:5) * Land (e.g. Luke 4:5) * Country * Earth (e.g. Matthew 5:5)</div> <div>Feminine noun. Connected to the English words “ground”, “geometry” and “geology”.</div> <div>It occurs throughout the LXX and the New Testament (approximately 250 times in the New Testament) and its meaning varies subtly on context, for example, in the LXX:Genesis 1:1Genesis 2:7Genesis 12:1 τῇ</div> <div>greek</div> <div>Meaning:</div> <div>* The</div> <div>The definite article.</div> <div>Forms</div> <div>Singular Case Masculine Feminine Neuter Nominative ὁ ἡ τό Genitive τοῦ τῆς τοῦ Dative τῷ τῇ ἰδίᾳ σου κρινῶ σε</div> |
