	The word אָרֶץ can designate the whole of planet earth, or the inhabitable world or the national territory or ground.
	When coupled with heavens (שָׁמַיִם), the phrase indicates the entire created order.Genesis 12:1 לְבַלְתִּי שְׁחֵתָה וְלֹא מְצֵאתִי
ESV	And I sought for a man among them who should build up the wall and stand in the breach before me for the land, that I should not destroy it, but I found none.
NIV	"I looked for a man among them who would build up the wall and stand before me in the gap on behalf of the land so I would not have to destroy it, but I found none.
NLT	"I looked for someone who might rebuild the wall of righteousness that guards the land. I searched for someone to stand in the gap in the wall so I wouldn't have to destroy the land, but I found no one.
