	hebrew The Hebrew אתְּ word does not have a corresponding word in English. In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence. It only ever occurs in conjunction with nouns associated with the definite article הַ.Genesis 1:1 שְׁבֹתַי חֲלֵלָה
ESV	You have despised my holy things and profaned my Sabbaths.
NIV	You have despised my holy things and desecrated my Sabbaths.
NLT	You despise my holy things and violate my Sabbath days of rest.
