ESV	She lusted after the Assyrians, governors and commanders, warriors clothed in full armor, horsemen riding on horses, all of them desirable young men.
NIV	She too lusted after the Assyrians-governors and commanders, warriors in full dress, mounted horsemen, all handsome young men.
NLT	She fawned over all the Assyrian officers- those captains and commanders in handsome uniforms, those charioteers driving their horses- all of them attractive young men.

Usage in the New Testament The sense of πᾶς depends on whether it modifies a singular or plural noun, and whether that noun is countable or uncountable. With singular countable nouns → "every" John 1:9John 3:16Romans 5:12Matthew 28:19Colossians 1:16Romans 3:23Romans 3:23John 3:16Colossians 1:17
