ESV	clothed in purple, governors and commanders, all of them desirable young men, horsemen riding on horses.
NIV	clothed in blue, governors and commanders, all of them handsome young men, and mounted horsemen.
NLT	They were all attractive young men, captains and commanders dressed in handsome blue, charioteers driving their horses.
LXX	ἐνδεδυκότας ὑακίνθινᾳ ἡγουμένους καὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as "and" στρατηγούς νεανίσκοι ἐπίλεκτοι πάντες greek Meaning * All * Every * The whole Adjective. Usage in the New Testament The sense of πᾶς depends on whether it modifies a singular or plural noun, and whether that noun is countable or uncountable. KJV	Which were clothed with blue, captains and rulers, all of them desirable young men, horsemen riding upon horses.

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
