	הִיְהִיּוּת plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bignִיְהִיּוּת hebrew The word הִיְהִיּוּת means “to exist” or “to be” or “to become” or “to come into being” and occurs 3561 times in the Old Testament. This is the foundational verb of existence, identity, becoming and occurrence. * It is used in the creation narrative of Genesis 1, represented by the English words Genesis 1:3Exodus 3:12Ruth 1:1Isaiah 2:2 וַיֵּשֶׁב עַד עוֹלָם
ESV	All who know you among the peoples are appalled at you; you have come to a dreadful end and shall be no more forever.”
NIV	All the nations who knew you are appalled at you; you have come to a horrible end and will be no more.”
NLT	All who knew you are appalled at your fate. You have come to a terrible end, and you will exist no more.”
