Hebrew	The Hebrew אֶת word does not have a corresponding word in English. In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence. For example, in Genesis 1:1 the word is preceded by בְּרֵא אֱלֹהִים (הָרִיו הַלְלִי גְבוּעוֹתֶיךָ וְגִאֻוֹתֶיךָ וְכָל אֲפִיקֶיךָ הַלְלִי הָרֶב יִפְּלוּ בָהֶם
ESV	And I will fill its mountains with the slain. On your hills and in your valleys and in all your ravines those slain with the sword shall fall.
NIV	I will fill your mountains with the slain; those killed by the sword will fall on your hills and in your valleys and in all your ravines.
NLT	I will fill your mountains with the dead. Your hills, your valleys, and your ravines will be filled with people slaughtered by the sword.
