In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence. It only ever occurs in conjunction with nouns associated with the definite article ה.Genesi‎s 1:1 הֵם עַם יִתְּנָה לָהֶם קִדְשִׁי בְּאֶמְכֶּר hebrew Meaning * Yahweh - God's personal name
Hebrew	It is not a generic term for "god", but rather the word יהוה (YHWH) is the name by which God uniquely identifies himself in the Old Testament. First appearing in Genesi‎s 2:4, it occurs over 6,000 times in the Old Testament.Exodus 3:14Deuteronomy 6:4Psalm 23:1Romans 10:13Joel 2:32Exodus 20:7Psalm 18:1Exodus 15:3Psalm 8:1Genesi‎s 2:41 Samuel 1:3Judges 6:24Genesi‎s 22:14Jeremiah 23:6 אֶלֶה וְסִמְנֵיהֶם hebrew Meaning: * Earth (e.g. Genesi‎s 1:1) or world * Land * Countries or country The word אֶרֶץ can designate the whole of planet earth, or the inhabitable world or the national territory or ground. When coupled with heavens (סְמִיָּם), the phrase indicates the entire created order.Genesi‎s 12:1 יְצֵאוּ
