The word הַּיָּה means "to exist" or "to be" or "to become" or "to come into being" and occurs 3561 times in the Old Testament.

This is the foundational verb of existence, identity, becoming and occurrence.

The Hebrew א word does not have a corresponding word in English. In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence. It only ever occurs in conjunction with nouns associated with the definite article a. Genesis 1:1

ESV "My servant David shall be king over them, and they shall all have one shepherd. They shall walk in my rules and be careful to obey my statutes.

NIV "My servant David will be king over them, and they will all have one shepherd. They will follow my laws and be careful to keep my decrees.

NLT "My servant David will be their king, and they will have only one shepherd. They will obey my regulations and be careful to keep my decrees.
