The word הָיָה means "to exist" or "to be" or "to become" or "to come into being" and occurs 3561 times in the Old Testament.

This is the foundational verb of existence, identity, becoming and occurrence.

* It is used in the creation narrative of Genesis 1, represented by the English words Genesis 1:3Exodus 3:12Ruth 1:1Isaiah 2:2 להם למשׁמר

ESV "Be ready and keep ready, you and all your hosts that are assembled about you, and be a guard for them.

NIV "'Get ready; be prepared, you and all the hordes gathered about you, and take command of them.

NLT "Get ready; be prepared! Keep all the armies around you mobilized, and take command of them.
