	* Earth (e.g. Genesis 1:1) or world * Land * Countries or country
	The word אֶרֶץ can designate the whole of planet earth, or the inhabitable world or the national territory or ground. When coupled with heavens (שָׁמַיִם), the phrase indicates the entire created order. Genesis 12:1 תִּשְׁתּוּ אֵילִים כְּבָרִים וְעֵתוּדִים פְּרִים מְרִיאֵי בָשָׂן כָּלֵם
ESV	You shall eat the flesh of the mighty, and drink the blood of the princes of the earth- of rams, of lambs, and of he-goats, of bulls, all of them fat beasts of Bashan.
NIV	You will eat the flesh of mighty men and drink the blood of the princes of the earth as if they were rams and lambs, goats and bulls-all of them fattened animals from Bashan.
NLT	Eat the flesh of mighty men and drink the blood of princes as though they were rams, lambs, goats, and bulls- all fattened animals from Bashan!
