Hebrew	hebrew The Hebrew את word does not have a corresponding word in English. In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence. For example, in Genesis 1:1 the word is preceded by בָּרָא אֱלֹהִים (הַעֲלֶה
ESV	There was a chamber with its door in the vestibule of the gate, where the burnt offering was to be washed.
NIV	A room with a doorway was by the portico in each of the inner gateways, where the burnt offerings were washed.
NLT	A door led from the entry room of one of the inner gateways into a side room, where the meat for sacrifices was washed.
