* Yahweh - God's personal name

lt is not a generic term for "god", but rather the word بِمَاِم (YHWH) is the name by which God uniquely identifies himself in the Old Testament.

ESV They shall not sell or exchange any of it. They shall not alienate this choice portion of the land, for it is holy to the LORD.

NIV They must not sell or exchange any of it. This is the best of the land and must not pass into other hands, because it is holy to the LORD.

NLT None of this special land may ever be sold or traded or used by others, for it belongs to the LORD; it is set apart as holy.
