ESV	And behold, the glory of the God of Israel was there, like the vision that I saw in the valley.
NIV	And there before me was the glory of the God of Israel, as in the vision I had seen in the plain.
NLT	Suddenly, the glory of the God of Israel was there, just as I had seen it before in the valley.

	Meaning

	Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and”
	ἰδοὺ ἐκεῖ ἦνplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigεἰμί
	greek
	εἰμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”).
	It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. δόξα κυρίου θεοῦplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigθεὸς

	The relative pronoun that connects a relative clause to a main clause, referring back to a noun or pronoun (called the antecedent).
	It is distinct from ὅτι (“that,” introducing indirect speech) and from ὅς as an interrogative in older Greek (meaning εἶδον ἐνplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigέν

	Preposition meaning “in”. τῷplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigὁ, ἡ, τό
