It is distinct from **ὅτι** ("that," introducing indirect speech) and from **ὅς** as an interrogative in older Greek (meaning **ἐκάθισεν γυναῖκας ἀλλοτρίας ἐλθέτωσαν εἰς καιροὺς ἀπὸ συνταγῶν καὶ**
