	שמר Meaning: * To guard * To protect * To keep * To observe * To attend The verb שמר occurs about 470 times in the Old Testament. Central in covenant language. God “keeps” His covenant promises, and His people are called to Deuteronomy 7:9Psalm 121:7Deuteronomy 7:11Psalm 127:1Luke 2:19 יהוה הלשכות בית יהוה לשכות בירושלם לישראל האבות ושרי האבות והלויים ושרי הכהנים לפני שקלי לפני שקלי עד תשקלו לפני שקלי עד תשקלו hebrew Meaning * Yahweh - God's personal name It is not a generic term for “god”, but rather the word יהוה (YHWH) is the name by which God uniquely identifies himself in the Old Testament.
