Different from εἰμί (which means “to be” - a state of existence); γίνομαι, instead, emphasizes coming to be - a transition or event.John 1:14John 1:3Matthew 6:10 εἰς Χριστόν,

Christ means “anointed one”		
The equivalent Hebrew word is Messiah (מָשִׁיחַ)		
Noun, masculine. ἵνα ἐκ πίστεως δικαιοθῶμεν·		
ESV	So then, the law was our guardian until Christ came, in order that we might be justified by faith.	
NIV	So the law was put in charge to lead us to Christ that we might be justified by faith.	
NLT	Let me put it another way. The law was our guardian until Christ came; it protected us until we could be made right with God through faith.	
KJV	Wherefore the law was our schoolmaster to bring us unto Christ, that we might be justified by faith.
