Hebrew	אֶת plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big hebrew The Hebrew אֶת word does not have a corresponding word in English. In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence. It only ever occurs in conjunction with nouns associated with the definite article הַ. Genesis 1:1 פֶּלֶג
ESV	When Eber had lived 34 years, he fathered Peleg.
NIV	When Eber had lived 34 years, he became the father of Peleg.
NLT	When Eber was 34 years old, he became the father of Peleg.
