## Meaning

\* Yahweh - God's personal name

It is not a generic term for "god", but rather the word יְהוָּה (YHWH) is the name by which God uniquely identifies himself in the Old Testament.

The Hebrew, אֵת word does not have a corresponding word in English. In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence.

For example, in Genesis 1:1 the word is preceded by פָּרֵא אֱלֹהֵים ( מִשֶּׁם עַל פְּנֵי כָל הָאֵרֶץ plugin-autotooltip\_\_default plugin-autotooltip bigy: אַרַקּאַ

\* Earth (e.g. Genesis 1:1) or world \* Land \* Countries or country

The word אֶבֶּר can designate the whole of planet earth, or the inhabitable world or the national territory or ground.

When coupled with heavens (שַׁמֵיִם), the phrase indicates the entire created order.Genesis 12:1 נֵיחָדְלִּי לְבַּנֶּת הָעִיר

ESV So the LORD dispersed them from there over the face of all the earth, and they left off building the city.

NIV So the LORD scattered them from there over all the earth, and they stopped building the city.

NLT In that way, the LORD scattered them all over the world, and they stopped building the city.

Usage in the New Testament

The sense of  $\pi \tilde{\alpha} \zeta$  depends on whether it modifies a singular or plural noun, and whether that noun is countable or uncountable.

Meaning:

\* Soil or ground (e.g. Matthew 13:5) \* Land (e.g. Luke 4:5) \* Country \* Earth (e.g. Matthew 5:5)

Feminine noun. Connected to the English words "ground", "geometry" and "geology".
