	Meaning * To kneel * To bless God as an act of adoration * To bless man as a benefit * Sometimes, to curse Verb, appearing approximately 330 times in the Old Testament. The word בָּרַךְ marks important moments of covenant, worship, inheritance and hope.Genesis 1:28Psalm 103:1Numbers 6:24 וְהָיָה שְׁמִי בְרָכָה plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigהָיָה Hebrew hebrew The word הָיָה means “to exist” or “to be” or “to become” or “to come into being” and occurs 3561 times in the Old Testament. This is the foundational verb of existence, identity, becoming and occurrence. * It is used in the creation narrative of Genesis 1, represented by the English words Genesis 1:3Exodus 3:12Ruth 1:1Isaiah 2:2 בְּרָכָה
ESV	And I will make of you a great nation, and I will bless you and make your name great, so that you will be a blessing.
NIV	“I will make you into a great nation and I will bless you; I will make your name great, and you will be a blessing.
