	אַרְצָךְ יֵשֵׁב בְּאַרְצְךָ אַבְרָם יֵשֵׁב בְּאַרְצְךָ hebrew Meaning: * Earth (e.g. Genesis 1:1) or world * Land * Countries or country The word אַרְצָךְ can designate the whole of planet earth, or the inhabitable world or the national territory or ground. When coupled with heavens (שָׁמַיִם), the phrase indicates the entire created order. Genesis 12:1 כָּנְעָן וְלוֹט יֹשְׁבֵי בְּעֵרֵי הַכְּפָר וַיֵּאָהֶל עַד סְדֹם
ESV	Abram settled in the land of Canaan, while Lot settled among the cities of the valley and moved his tent as far as Sodom.
NIV	Abram lived in the land of Canaan, while Lot lived among the cities of the plain and pitched his tents near Sodom.
NLT	So Abram settled in the land of Canaan, and Lot moved his tents to a place near Sodom and settled among the cities of the plain.
