The Hebrew אֵת word does not have a corresponding word in English. In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence.

For example, in Genesis 1:1 the word is preceded by בְּרֵא אֱלֹהֵים ( הָאֶרֶץ plugin-autotooltip\_\_default plugin-autotooltip bigy\_\_default plugin-autotooltip bigy\_default plug

## Hebrew

The word אֶּרֶץ can designate the whole of planet earth, or the inhabitable world or the national territory or ground.

When coupled with heavens (שָׁמֵיִם), the phrase indicates the entire created order.Genesis 12:1 לָשֵׁבֶּת יַּחְדֵּו כִּי הַיָּחַplugin-autotooltip default plugin-autotooltip bigהַהָה

## hebrew

The word הָיָה means "to exist" or "to be" or "to become" or "to come into being" and occurs 3561 times in the Old Testament.

This is the foundational verb of existence, identity, becoming and occurrence.

\* It is used in the creation narrative of Genesis 1, represented by the English words Genesis 1:3Exodus 3:12Ruth 1:1Isaiah 2:2 רְכוּשָׁם ֹרָב וְלָאׁ יֵכְלוּ לְשֵׁבֶת יַחְדֵּו

so that the land could not support both of them dwelling together; for their possessions were so great that they could not dwell together,

NIV

But the land could not support them while they stayed together, for their possessions were so great that they were not able to stay together.

NLT But the land could not support both Abram and Lot with all their flocks and herds living so close together.

Feminine noun. Connected to the English words "ground", "geometry" and "geology".

LXX

It occurs throughout the LXX and the New Testament (approximately 250 times in the New Testament) and its meaning varies subtly on context, for example, in the LXX:Genesis 1:1Genesis 2:7Genesis 12:1 κατοικεῖν ἄμα ὅτι ἦνplugin-autotooltip\_default plugin-autotooltip\_bigεἰμί

greek

εἰμί is the first person singular verb for "to be" (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = "to be").

It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. τὰplugin-autotooltip default plugin-autotooltip bigò
