ESV	Therefore the well was called Beer-lahai-roi; it lies between Kadesh and Bered.
NIV	That is why the well was called Beer Lahai Roi; it is still there, between Kadesh and Bered.
	So that well was named Beer-lahai-roi (which means "well of the Living One who sees me"). It can still be found between Kadesh and Bered.

It is distinct from ὅτι ("that," introducing indirect speech) and from ὅς as an interrogative in older Greek (meaning ἐνώπιον εἶδον ἰδοὺ ἀνὰ μέσον Καδης καὶplugin-autotooltip\_default plugin-autotooltip\_bigκαί

\* And \* Also \* Both \* Even \* Too \* So

Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as "and" ἀνὰ μέσον Βαραδ
