Hebrew	The Hebrew את word does not have a corresponding word in English. In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence. For example, in Genesis 1:1 the word is preceded by בְּרִיתִי אֶקִּים אֶת יִצְחָק אֲשֶׁר תֵּלֵד לָךְ שָׂרָה לְמוֹעֵד הַזֶּה בַּשָּׁנָה הָאַחֶרֶת

Occurs 703 times in the New Testament. πρός is a common preposition in Koine Greek that carries different meanings. It most frequently takes the accusative case, but at times it takes the genitive or dative cases, giving it a different meaning again. At its core, it usually describes movement or relationship toward someone or something, whether physical, s...
