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| LXX | <div>Αβρααμ δέplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigδέ</div> <div>greek</div> <div>δέ is a conjunction that can mean “but” or “and” or “also” or “moreover”. It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. ἦνplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigεἰμί</div> <div>greek</div> <div>εἰμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”).</div> <div>It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense.
