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|     | <div>הִיא</div> <div>plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big</div> <div>hebrew</div> <div>The word הִיא means “to exist” or “to be” or “to become” or “to come into being” and occurs 3561 times in the Old Testament.</div> <div>This is the foundational verb of existence, identity, becoming and occurrence.</div> <div>* It is used in the creation narrative of Genesis 1, represented by the English words Genesis 1:3Exodus 3:12Ruth 1:1Isaiah 2:2 הִיא הָיָה אֵלֶּיךָ</div> <div>את</div> <div>hebrew</div> <div>Hebrew</div> <div>The Hebrew את word does not have a corresponding word in English. Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament.</p> <p>Core uses Function English Equivalent Typical Translation Example (Greek) Example (English) ταύτηνplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigοὗτος / αὕτη / τοῦτο</p> <p>LXX greek</p> <p>Meaning:</p> <p>* These or this * This one, this person, this thing * They or he or she or it</p> <p>Demonstrative pronoun.</p> <p>οὗτος usually refers to something close to the speaker — “this” as opposed to ἐκεῖνος (John 9:161 John 5:111 Corinthians 15:501 John 4:9John 5:1Matthew 3:17John 7:26Luke 22:19 τὴνplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigὁ</p> <p>greek</p> <p>The definite article δικαιοσύνην ποιήσειςplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigποιέω</p> <p>Meaning:</p> <p>* To do * To make</p> <p>This verb - to do or make - is used in connection with a large range of activities including creation, covenant formation, obedience, miracles, sin and worship.</p> <p>Verb forms</p> <p>Present tense Person Greek Form ἐπ ἐμέ εἰς πάνταplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigπάντες</p> <p>greek</p> <p>Meaning</p> <p>* All * Every * The whole</p> <p>Adjective.</p> <p>Usage in the New Testament</p> <p>The sense of πάντες depends on whether it modifies a singular or plural noun, and whether that noun is countable or uncountable.</p> <p>With singular countable nouns → "every" John 1:9John 3:16Romans 5:12Matthew 28:19Colossians 1:16Romans 3:23Romans 3:23John 3:16Colossians 1:17 τόπον οὗ ἂν εἰσέλθωμεν ἐκεῖ εἰπὼν ἐμὲ ὅτι ἀδελφός μου ἐστίνplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigεἰμί</p> <p>greek</p> <p>εἰμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”).</p> <p>It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g.</p> |
