	וַיָּהִי hebrew The word וַיָּהִי means “to exist” or “to be” or “to become” or “to come into being” and occurs 3561 times in the Old Testament. This is the foundational verb of existence, identity, becoming and occurrence. * It is used in the creation narrative of Genesis 1, represented by the English words Genesis 1:3Exodus 3:12Ruth 1:1Isaiah 2:2 חַיֵּי שָׂרָה מֵאָה שָׁנָה וְעֶשְׂרִים שָׁנָה וְשִׁבְעַ שָׁנִים שְׁנֵי חַיֵּי שָׂרָה
ESV	Sarah lived 127 years; these were the years of the life of Sarah.
NIV	Sarah lived to be a hundred and twenty-seven years old.

LXX	ἐγένετο δέ greek δέ is a conjunction that can mean “but” or “and” or “also” or “moreover”.
