Hebrew	בָּרַךְ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big ויִבְרַךְ Meaning * To kneel * To bless God as an act of adoration * To bless man as a benefit * Sometimes, to curse Verb, appearing approximately 330 times in the Old Testament. The word בָּרַךְ marks important moments of covenant, worship, inheritance and hope.
