	* Yahweh - God's personal name
	lt is not a generic term for "god", but rather the word יְהוָּה (YHWH) is the name by which God uniquely identifies himself in the Old Testament.

εἰμί is the first person singular verb for "to be" (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = "to be").
