Hebrew	Noun, masculine אֶת plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigאֶת hebrew The Hebrew אֶת word does not have a corresponding word in English. In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence. For example, in Genesis 1:1 the word is preceded by לִי מִקְנֵה אֲבִיכֶם וְיִתְּנוּ לִי
ESV	Thus God has taken away the livestock of your father and given them to me.
NIV	So God has taken away your father's livestock and has given them to me.
NLT	In this way, God has taken your father's animals and given them to me.

	Usage in the New Testament
	The sense of πᾶς depends on whether it modifies a singular or plural noun, and whether that noun is countable or uncountable.
	With singular countable nouns → "every" John 1:9John 3:16Romans 5:12Matthew 28:19Colossians 1:16Romans 3:23Romans 3:23John 3:16Colossians 1:17 τὰplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigτὰ

	Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament.
