Hebrew	וַיֹּאמֶר אֱלֹהֵי מֶה שְׂמֶךְךָ וַיֹּאמֶר יַעֲקֹב
ESV	Then he said, "Your name shall no longer be called Jacob, but Israel, for you have striven with God and with men, and have prevailed."
NIV	Then the man said, "Your name will no longer be Jacob, but Israel, because you have struggled with God and with men and have overcome."
NLT	"Your name will no longer be Jacob," the man told him. "From now on you will be called Israel, because you have fought with God and with men and have won."

LXX	εἶπεν δὲ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigδέ greek δέ is a conjunction that can mean “but” or “and” or “also” or “moreover”. It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. αὐτῷ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigαὐτός greek Meaning * He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament. Core uses Function English Equivalent Typical Translation Example (Greek) Example (English) οὐ κληθήσεται ἔτι τὸ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigὁ greek The definite article ὄνομά σου Ιακωβ ἀλλὰ Ισραηλ ἔσται plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigεἰμί greek εἰμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”). It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. τὸ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigὁ greek The definite article ὄνομά σου ὅτι ἐνίσχυσας μετὰ θεοῦ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigθεὸς greek Masculine noun meaning: * A god or goddess * God καὶ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigκαί greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” μετὰ ἀνθρώπων δυνατός
