The Hebrew **אֶת** word does not have a corresponding word in English. In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence.

For example, in Genesis 1:1 the word is preceded by **בְּרָא אֱלֹהִים (הַיְלֹדִים עַל לֵאמֹה וְעַל רָחֵל וְעַל שְׁתֵּי הַשְּׂפָחוֹת)**
