

Genesis 34:1

Hebrew	אֶרֶץ לְרִאיוֹת בְּנֹת הָאָרֶץ לְעֵקֶב יִלְדָּה אֲשֶׁר לְאָה בֵּת דִּינָה וַתֵּצֵא hebrew Meaning: * Earth (e.g. Genesis 1:1) or world * Land * Countries or country The word אֶרֶץ can designate the whole of planet earth, or the inhabitable world or the national territory or ground. When coupled with heavens (שָׁמַיִם), the phrase indicates the entire created order. Genesis 12:1
ESV	Now Dinah the daughter of Leah, whom she had borne to Jacob, went out to see the women of the land.
NIV	Now Dinah, the daughter Leah had borne to Jacob, went out to visit the women of the land.
NLT	One day Dinah, the daughter of Jacob and Leah, went to visit some of the young women who lived in the area.
LXX	ὁ δὲ ἐξῆλθεν δὲ greek δὲ is a conjunction that can mean “but” or “and” or “also” or “moreover”. It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. Δινα ἡ greek The definite article ἡ Λεῖας ἣν ἔτεκεν τῷ greek The definite article ἡ καταμαθεῖν τὰς greek The definite article ἡ τῶν greek The definite article ἡ ἐγγυρῶν
KJV	And Dinah the daughter of Leah, which she bare unto Jacob, went out to see the daughters of the land.

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
