	δέ is a conjunction that can mean “but” or “and” or “also” or “moreover”. It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. Παχὴλ καὶ

	Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” ἑτάφη ἐν

	Preposition meaning “in”. τῇ

	The definite article ὁδῶ Εφραθα αὕτη
	οὗτος / αὕτη / τοῦτο
	greek
	Meaning:
	* These or this * This one, this person, this thing * They or he or she or it
	Demonstrative pronoun.
	οὗτος usually refers to something close to the speaker — “this” as opposed to ἐκεῖνος (John 9:161 John 5:111 Corinthians 15:501 John 4:9John 5:1Matthew 3:17John 7:26Luke 22:19 ἔστιν
	greek
	εἰμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”).
	It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. Βηθλεεμ
KJV	And Rachel died, and was buried in the way to Ephrath, which is Bethlehem.
