Demonstrative pronoun.

οὗτος usually refers to something close to the speaker — “this” as opposed to ἐκεῖνος (John 9:161 John 5:111 Corinthians 15:501 John 4:9John 5:1Matthew 3:17John 7:26Luke 22:19 ἡγεμόνες Ελιφας ἐν plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big ἐν

greek

Preposition meaning “in”. γῆ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big γῆ

Meaning:

* Soil or ground (e.g. Matthew 13:5) * Land (e.g. Luke 4:5) * Country * Earth (e.g. Matthew 5:5)

Feminine noun. Connected to the English words “ground”, “geometry” and “geology”.

It occurs throughout the LXX and the New Testament (approximately 250 times in the New Testament) and its meaning varies subtly on context, for example, in the LXX:Genesis 1:1Genesis 2:7Genesis 12:1 Ἰδουμαία οὗτοι plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big οὗτος / αὕτη / τοῦτο
