	Meaning:
	* Earth (e.g. Genesis 1:1) or world * Land * Countries or country
	The word אֲרָץ can designate the whole of planet earth, or the inhabitable world or the national territory or ground. When coupled with heavens (שָׁמַיִם), the phrase indicates the entire created order. Genesis 12:1 אֲדֹמִים לִפְנֵי

	* Face * Presence * Front or surface
	Noun. Masculine. Although it looks plural in form (ending in -ים), it is almost always used as a singular in meaning - a type of plural of intensity or plural of form common in Hebrew for body parts that come in pairs or have multiple aspects. מֶלֶךְ מֶלֶךְ לִבְנֵי יִשְׂרָאֵל

	Demonstrative pronoun.
	οὗτος usually refers to something close to the speaker — “this” as opposed to ἐκεῖνος (John 9:161 John 5:111 Corinthians 15:501 John 4:9John 5:1Matthew 3:17John 7:26Luke 22:19 οἱ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigὁ, ἡ, τό
