	The Hebrew אתָּ word does not have a corresponding word in English. In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence.
	For example, in Genesis 1:1 the word is preceded by בָּרָא אֱלֹהִים (וַיִּתְּנֵהוּ אֶל בֵּית הַסֵּהֶר מִקּוֹם אֲשֶׁר אִסּוּרֵי אֶסְיֵרִי הַמֶּלֶךְ אִסּוּרִים וַיְהִי הָיָה plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big

	The word הָיָה means “to exist” or “to be” or “to become” or “to come into being” and occurs 3561 times in the Old Testament. This is the foundational verb of existence, identity, becoming and occurrence. * It is used in the creation narrative of Genesis 1, represented by the English words Genesis 1:3Exodus 3:12Ruth 1:1Isaiah 2:2 שֵׁם בְּבֵית הַסֵּהֶר
ESV	And Joseph's master took him and put him into the prison, the place where the king's prisoners were confined, and he was there in prison.
NIV	Joseph's master took him and put him in prison, the place where the king's prisoners were confined. But while Joseph was there in the prison,
NLT	So he took Joseph and threw him into the prison where the king's prisoners were held, and there he remained.
