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δέ is a conjunction that can mean "but" or "and" or "also" or "moreover". It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English.

Usage in the New Testament

The sense of πάντες depends on whether it modifies a singular or plural noun, and whether that noun is countable or uncountable.

With singular countable nouns → "every" John 1:9John 3:16Romans 5:12Matthew 28:19Colossians 1:16Romans 3:23John 3:16Colossians 1:17 τῷplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigὸ

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The definite article γενῶν ὧν ὁplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigὸ

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The definite article βασιλεὺς Φαραῶ ἐσθίει ἔργον σιτοποιοῦ καὶplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigκαί

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Meaning

* And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So

Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as "and" τὰ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigὸ

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The definite article πετεινὰ τοῦ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigὸ

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The definite article οὐρανοῦ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigὸ οὐρανός

Meaning:

* The sky * Air * Heaven or heavens

278 occurrences in the New Testament.

Οὐρανός is used in Scripture to describe the sky and universe (that is, the visible expanse above the earth) as well as the transcendent realm where God is present. For example, in Matthew 6:26Matthew 24:29Matthew 6:9 κατήσθινεν αὐτὰ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigαὐτός
