Hebrew	וְהָיָה שִׁבְעַ שְׂבָלִים צִנְמוֹת דְּקוֹת שְׂדֵפוֹת קִדִּים צִמְחוּ אַחֲרֵיהֶם
ESV	Seven ears, withered, thin, and blighted by the east wind, sprouted after them,
NIV	After them, seven other heads sprouted-withered and thin and scorched by the east wind.
NLT	Then seven more heads of grain appeared, but these were blighted, shriveled, and withered by the east wind.
LXX	ἄλλοι δὲ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigδέ greek δέ is a conjunction that can mean “but” or “and” or “also” or “moreover”. It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. ἐπὶ τὰ στάχυες λεπτοὶ καὶ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigκαί greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” ἀνεμόφθοροι ἀνεφύοντο ἐχόμενοι αὐτῶν plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigαὐτός greek Meaning * He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same Personal pronoun (reflexive).
