	אֶרֶץ שְׁבַע שָׁנִים בָּאוֹת שְׁבַע גָּדוֹל בְּכָל אֶרֶץ hebrew Meaning: * Earth (e.g. Genesis 1:1) or world * Land * Countries or country The word אֶרֶץ can designate the whole of planet earth, or the inhabitable world or the national territory or ground. When coupled with heavens (שָׁמַיִם), the phrase indicates the entire created order. Genesis 12:1 מִצְרַיִם
ESV	There will come seven years of great plenty throughout all the land of Egypt,
NIV	Seven years of great abundance are coming throughout the land of Egypt,
NLT	The next seven years will be a period of great prosperity throughout the land of Egypt.
	ἰδοὺ ἐπὶ τὰ ἔτη ἔρχεται εὐθηνία πολλὴ ἐν greek Preposition meaning "in". πάσῃ greek Meaning * All * Every * The whole Adjective. Usage in the New Testament
LXX	The sense of πᾶς depends on whether it modifies a singular or plural noun, and whether that noun is countable or uncountable. With singular countable nouns → "every" John 1:9 John 3:16 Romans 5:12 Matthew 28:19 Colossians 1:16 Romans 3:23 John 3:16 Colossians 1:17 γῆ Meaning: * Soil or ground (e.g. Matthew 13:5) * Land (e.g. Luke 4:5) * Country * Earth (e.g. Matthew 5:5) Feminine noun. Connected to the English words "ground", "geometry" and "geology". It occurs throughout the LXX and the New Testament (approximately 250 times in the New Testament) and its meaning varies subtly on context, for example, in the LXX: Genesis 1:1 Genesis 2:7 Genesis 12:1 Αἰγύπτῳ
