The Hebrew אֵת word does not have a corresponding word in English. In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence.

For example, in Genesis 1:1 the word is preceded by בָּרֵא אֱלֹהֵים (אֲחִיכֶּם הַקְּטֹן תָּבֵיאוּ אֵלַי וְיֵאָמְנְוּ דִּבְרֵיכֶּם בָּרָא אֱלֹהִים (אֲחִיכֶם הַקְּטֹן תָּבִיאוּ אֵלַי וְיֵאָמְנִּוּ דִּבְרֵיכֶּם זְּלָאׁ תָמֶוּתוּ וַיַּצְשׁוֹּ בֵּן
