Hebrew	וַיֵּרְדּוּ אֶחָד יוֹסֵף עֲשָׂרָה לְשָׁבֵר בָּר מִמִּצְרַיִם
ESV	So ten of Joseph's brothers went down to buy grain in Egypt.
NIV	Then ten of Joseph's brothers went down to buy grain from Egypt.
NLT	So Joseph's ten older brothers went down to Egypt to buy grain.
LXX	κατέβησαν δὲ greek δέ is a conjunction that can mean “but” or “and” or “also” or “moreover”. It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. οἱ greek The definite article ἀδελφοὶ Ἰωσήφ οἱ greek The definite article δέκα πρίασθαι σῖτον ἐξ Αἰγύπτου
KJV	And Joseph's ten brethren went down to buy corn in Egypt.

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
