Hebrew	וַיִּמְרְרוּהוּ וַיַּרְבּוּ וַיִּשְׁטְמוּהוּ בַּעֲלֵי חַצְצִים
ESV	The archers bitterly attacked him, shot at him, and harassed him severely,
NIV	With bitterness archers attacked him; they shot at him with hostility.
NLT	Archers attacked him savagely; they shot at him and harassed him.
LXX	εἰς δὲ διαβουλεύόμενοι ἔλαιοδόρουν καὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” ἐνείχον αὐτῷ greek Meaning * He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament.
