Hebrew	The Hebrew את word does not have a corresponding word in English. In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence. For example, in Genesis 1:1 the word is preceded by בְּרָא אֱלֹהִים (אֱנוֹשׁ שֶׁבַע שָׁנִים וּשְׁמֹנֶה מֵאוֹת שָׁנָה וַיּוֹלֶד בָּנִים וּבָנוֹת)
ESV	Seth lived after he fathered Enosh 807 years and had other sons and daughters.
NIV	And after he became the father of Enosh, Seth lived 807 years and had other sons and daughters.
NLT	After the birth of Enosh, Seth lived another 807 years, and he had other sons and daughters.
